December 21, 1933 - August 30, 2012

Betty Ann (Weaver) Combs, 78, of Zanesville, died peacefully at her residence following a four-year battle with Alzheimer's disease. She was born Thursday, December 21, 1933 in Hemlock, the daughter of Emmett G. Weaver and Florence (Allen-Stoneburner) Weaver. She married the late Robert E. "Bob" Combs, the love of her life, on Saturday, September 5, 1953.

Betty was a member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church and a committed lifelong Lutheran. She had a strong faith and was conservative in her beliefs. Betty was a dedicated and active Republican and had a passionate work ethic. Betty retired in 2003 following over 50 years of service to the Muskingum County Treasurers Office as Senior Deputy. During her tenure, she had the opportunity to service under five County Treasurers. She also served as Clerk for The Village of Fultonham for over 25 years. In her fifties, she took a class in cake decorating and, within a short time, her interest became an active cake baking business, providing wedding and anniversary cakes to many area couples. She loved to play the organ, in her own words, "for my pleasure only". She enjoyed crocheting, needlepoint and spending time with her family and friends. Betty enjoyed life to the fullest, had a great sense of humor and never met a stranger. Betty was a loving and caring wife and mother and mother-in-law.

Betty is survived by her son and daughter-in-law: Tim & Ann Combs of Zanesville; her devoted four legged companions: Mini, Maggie and Bo; special friends; Bev Foley and Bart and Kate Hagemeyer all of Zanesville; one
