



## Burnidetta Eva Hodgson

December 21, 1920 - October 4, 2015

Burnidetta Eva Hodgson, 94 of Zanesville, died 7:20 AM, Sunday, October 4, 2015 at Willow Haven Care Center following a lengthy battle with Parkinson's Disease. She was born Tuesday, December 21, 1920 in Zanesville, the daughter of Harry Matheney and Inez (Morris) Matheney and was Methodist by Faith.

Burnidetta served her country as a veteran of the United States Army Air Corp, WAC from 1944 to 1946. During her tenure she was stationed in New Mexico during the development and testing of the Atomic Bomb in White Sands, New Mexico. When she returned home she was employed by Ohio Bell and Essex Wire. Burnidetta was a Lifetime member of the American Legion Post 29.

Burnidetta is survived by one daughter: Jeane (Bill) Spangler; two grandchildren: Chad (Robyn) Spangler and Shanon (Dusty) Marple all of Zanesville; three great grandsons: Dallas Marple, Christian & Tylleston Spangler; one nephew: Pat (Kathy) Matheney of Columbus; two nieces: Joy (Bob) Harrier of Zanesville and Donna (Jimmy) McCumber of Texas. In addition to her parents, Burnidetta was preceded in death by her brother: Harry "Pat" Matheney, her former husband: George "Russ" Hodgson and one niece: Diane Orr.
