



Carl V. Roberts Jr.

January 19, 1943 - April 5, 2021

Carl V., "Bud", Roberts, Jr., died at his home at 9:00 AM on Monday, April 5, 2021, following a brief illness.

Graveside Services for Carl will be held 12:00 PM, Saturday, June 26, 2021, at Fultonham Cemetery in Fultonham, with Rev. Jeep Graham officiating. The United States Army, VFW Post 1058 and American Legion Post 29 will conduct full military honors. Following the graveside service a Celebration to Honor Carl's Life will take place at the Graham Family Farm at 1:00 PM.

Carl was born January 19, 1943 in Newark, the son of Carl V. Roberts, Sr. and Betty (Reed) Roberts. He married Kristie (Graham) Roberts on August 17, 1990, and was a member of East Fultonham United Methodist Church.

Carl served his country in the United States Army during the Vietnam War, and retired from Owens Corning over following 36 years of service. He enjoyed woodworking, riding his Harley, camping, and spending time outdoors. Carl had a great sense of humor and never met a stranger. He enjoyed spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren, and with his "4 legged" family.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by one daughter Robin (David Rodgers) Roberts of Harrisburg, PA; one son Jonathan (Amanda) Roberts of Norwich;
