Carlos Robert "Monk" Landers, 86 of Zanesville, died after a sudden illness at Genesis Hospital on December 14th, 2015. He was born in Zanesville, August 11, 1929 the son of the late Robert Landers & Marie (Fischer) Landers Pyles.

Carlos retired from Armco Steel in 1990 following 39 years of dedicated Service. He was an active member of St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church and Knights of Columbus Council 505. He served his country as a veteran of the United States Army serving in Germany during WWII.

Carlos was a loving father to his children Cathy (John) Blair, Tim (Kathy) Landers, Tom (Christy) Landers and Carla (Roger) Spencer.
