September 12, 1943 - October 16, 2014

Claude J. Foley, 71 of Zanesville, died 10:28 PM Thursday, October 16, 2014 at Genesis Morrison House Hospice in Zanesville, following a long illness. He was born Sunday, September 12, 1943 in Pittsburgh, PA the son of Henry J. Foley and Marjory F. (Brown) Foley. He married Beverly J. "Bev" (Magill) Foley on Saturday, January 4, 1964 and they celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary this January.

Claude served his country as a veteran of The United States Air Force where he served in Italy. He worked for The Roekel Company, retiring following 33 years of service.
