David R. Toole, age 75 of Zanesville, died 6:40 AM, Sunday, April 26, 2015 at the Oaks at Northpointe. He was born Sunday, February 18, 1940 in Zanesville, the son of John L. Toole and Lilian (Crock) Toole and was a member of St. Nicholas Catholic Church.

David served his country as a veteran of the United States Army during the Vietnam Era. He retired from Owens Corning Fiber Glass in 1996, following 20 years of service as a pipe fitter. He was also formerly employed at Armco Steel for 11 years and Kroger's for 8 years. He was a member of the International Association of Machinist & Aerospace Workers, Lodge #1280. David enjoyed hunting and fishing. He was a volunteer rescue scuba diver in his younger years.

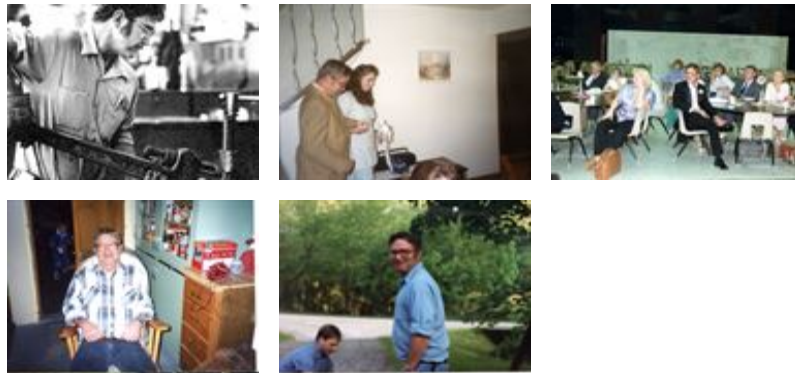
