Douglas Michael Dovenbarger, 64 of Zanesville, formerly of Cincinnati, died 1:40 PM Friday, August 29, 2014 at Genesis Morrison House Hospice following a lengthy illness. He was born Saturday, February 25, 1950 in Zanesville, the son of Kenneth Virgil Dovenbarger and Fern Eileen (Freeman) Dovenbarger.

Douglas served his country as a veteran of The United States Marine Corps. He attended MIT in Cambridge, MA and received his B.S. in Mathematics, Summa Cum Laude from The Ohio State University. Wolfson Fellowship; and a M.Eng. from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institution and received his Law Degree, Order of the Coif from University of Houston.

Douglas enjoyed Martial Arts, science and mathematics as his hobbies. He was employed by several prestigious companies across the United States including Naval Underwater Systems Center, Hughes Aircraft, General Motors and Proctor & Gamble.

Douglas is survived by one sister: Debra Dovenbarger (Murry Booth) of Seattle, WA and several cousins.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

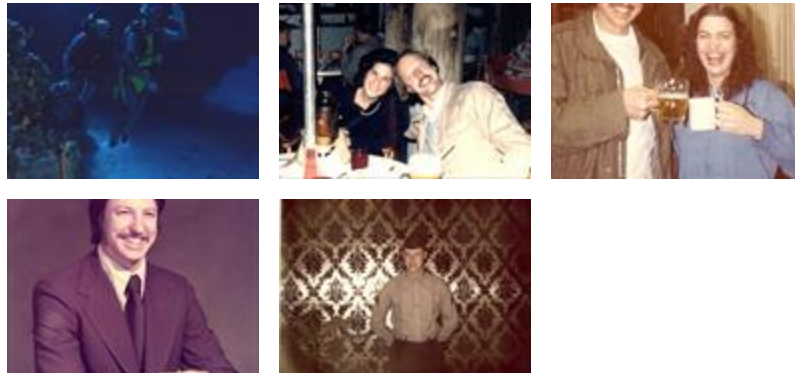
