Eleanor W. Show, 93 of Zanesville, died Saturday, August 30, 2014 peacefully at her residence following a sudden illness. She was born Sunday, August 21, 1921 in Wynne PA the daughter of Robert Wheeler and Mary (Ramage) Wheeler. She married Wayne Show on Saturday, December 20, 1947 and was a member of Norval Park Church of Christ.
