Eugene "Gene" F. Archer, 90 of Zanesville, passed peacefully surrounded by his family at 4:30 PM, Wednesday, March 6, 2019, at Clay Gardens Place. He was born Sunday, April 29, 1928 in Zanesville, the son of Francis and Rosa M (Hughes) Archer. He married Billie Ann Vaughn on Saturday, August 5, 1950, and was a member of St. Nicholas Catholic Church.
