



Gerald F. "Jerry" Pfeifer

May 13, 1930 - April 18, 2014

Gerald F. "Jerry" Pfeifer, 83 of Zanesville, died peacefully at 8:50 PM Friday, April 18, 2014 at Willow Haven Care Center, surrounded by his family. He was born Monday, May 12, 1930 in Zanesville, the son of Fred T. Pfeifer and Mary (Silvus) Pfeifer. He married Glenna (Maxwell) Pfeifer on Saturday, June 16, 1951 and was a member of St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church.

Jerry served his country as a veteran of the United States Army during the Korean Conflict. He was a bricklayer and retired following many years in the local construction industry. As a local bricklayer Jerry had a hand in laying brick for many of the finest buildings in Zanesville and the surrounding community. He was a member of the International Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers Local # 44 and the Knights of Columbus Council # 505. He enjoyed hunting, camping, fishing and was an avid square dancer. He drew great pleasure from finding treasures with his metal detector. Jerry was a loving and caring husband and father who greatly enjoyed the time he spent with his family, close friends and his pets.
