



## Glenn R. McCutcheon

November 26, 1936 - October 23, 2016

Glenn Roy McCutcheon, age 79 of Zanesville, passed peacefully with his family by his side at 8:25 AM, Sunday, October 23, 2016 at his home following a long illness.
