Harold J. Denman, 85 of Nashport, died 3:55 AM Wednesday, December 13, 2012 at Forest View Health Campus following a lengthy illness. He was born Thursday, September 1, 1927 in Zanesville, the son of Lester J. Denman and Lola Marie (Wiles) Denman. Harold served this country as a veteran of The United States Navy during World War II. He was a self-employed carpet installer.
