James "Jim" Dickson, 54, of Nashport, passed away 4:30 am, Wednesday, February 20, 2019, at Genesis Hospital, following complications from a brain aneurysm. He was born February 9, 1965, in Zanesville, the son of Robert & Louise (Hivnor) Dickson.

Jim was a graduate of Maysville High School, Mid East Career Center specializing in Electronics, and attended MATC. Jim retired from Armco/AK Steel in 2015 following over 32 years of service. During his tenure at Armco/AK he served as ZAIO Union President.
