John H. Diveley, 83 of Zanesville, died 9:04 PM, Monday, September 11, 2017, at Genesis Hospital following a brief illness. He was born Tuesday, July 17, 1934, in Enid, OK, the son of John F Diveley and Allene (Haughey) Diveley. He married Sue (Stine) Diveley on Wednesday, June 27, 2001, who he affectionately called his “Baby Girl”. John was a member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church.

John faithfully and proudly served his country as a veteran of the United States Navy during the Korean War. He continued his service to his country with the United States Air Force during the Vietnam War. John served with “20 years and 20 days” of dedicated service to his country retiring as a Master Sergeant.

He previously enjoyed beekeeping, wine making, especially his plum wine and working on his farm in Cumberland, Ohio. 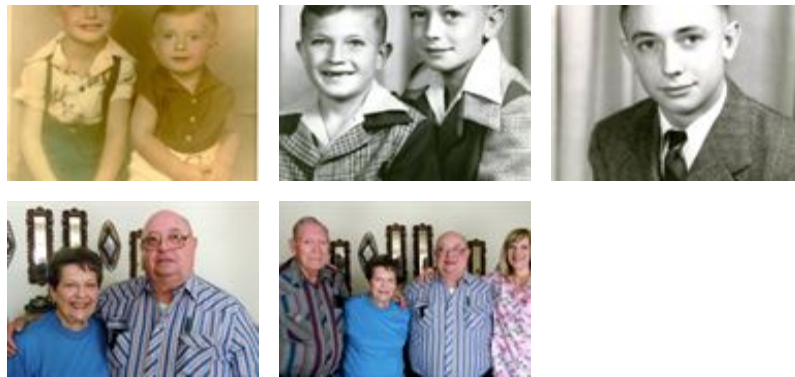
