



## John O. "Pat" Welsh

May 16, 1924 - January 22, 2015

John O. "Pat" Welsh, age 90 of Zanesville died 8:14 AM, Thursday, January 22, 2015 at his home following a brief illness.

He was born Friday, May 16, 1924 in Dover, the son of John Regis Welsh and Ora (Schilling) Welsh. He was married on Saturday, December 27, 1947 to Flora Lee (Banks) Welsh who preceded him in death on Sunday, January 17, 1999.
