Larry Lee Paul, 90, of Zanesville, died, Monday, October 13, 2025, at his home. He was born Saturday, July 13, 1935, in Zanesville, the son of Joseph A. Paul and Dorothy M. (Gassner) Paul. He married Carolyn L. (Harris) Paul on Saturday, November 16, 1974, and was a long-time faithful member of St. Nicholas Catholic Church.

Larry was Bricklayer by trade, and served as Vice President for Paul Contracting, Maple Avenue.
