Lawrence W. "Larry" Gibson, 77 of Zanesville, died Thursday, November 21, 2013 at Kindred Health Care in Newark following a brief illness due to complications of Alzheimer's Disease. He was born Sunday, December 15, 1935 in Zanesville, the son of Ernest Gibson and Helen (Miller) Gibson. He married Virginia R. (Harper) Gibson on Friday, February 14, 1958 and was a member of St. Luke's Lutheran Church.
