November 17, 1928 - January 25, 2023

Mary Ann Young, age 94 of Zanesville, passed away peacefully at 7:10 pm, Wednesday, January 25, 2023 at Altercare, Zanesville.

She was born November 17, 1928, in Cleveland, Ohio the daughter of Guisepppe (Joseph Charles)

Imperiale and Nancy (Nunzia Triassi) Imperiale, immigrants to the United States from Italy. She was

married to Charles F. Young of Cumberland, OH September 20, 1947, after meeting in a Cleveland diner where Mary Ann worked, and Charles stopped to eat while working his railroad route from Zanesville to Cleveland. He preceded her in death on June 2, 1992, after nearly 45 years of marriage.

A member of St. Nicholas Catholic Church, she enjoyed singing in the choir when she was younger. Mary Ann was a long-time employee of Good Samaritan Medical Center where she retired in 1995. She returned to work at Genesis HealthCare System for several years, retiring again in 2002 after a total of 35 years of service.

Mary Ann was a member of Muskingum CCL, Good Samaritan Charity Circle, and the Fraternal Order of Eagles Ladies Auxiliary. Once retired, Mary Ann's passions were line dancing with friends at the Muskingum County Center for Seniors, meeting friends from the hospital regularly for breakfast, and following the very active lives of her children and grandchildren.
