Michael G. Cone, 61 of Zanesville, died 4:20 PM Friday, October 19, 2012 at The Ohio State University Hospital following a lengthy illness. He was born Monday, November 27, 1950 in Amesville, the son of Robert Cone and Dorothy (Sharp) Cone. He married Beverly (Kuhn) Cone on Wednesday, June 21, 1995 and was a member of Fultonham United Methodist Church where he served as a liturgist.

Michael retired from the Muskingum County Sheriff's department. He was a graduate of Federal Hocking High School and attended Hocking Valley College. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army. He played drums in many bands in Southeastern Ohio, including Flashback, Occasion Band, U B Shaken, Backside, Set Apart Band, Phil Edwards Blues, Rapture, The Royal Colony and D&R Studio Band. He also worked for Advanced Auto Parts, Rittberger Meats, Ace Hardware and with Lee Gillespie at the Custom Sounds Shop. Michael was also a member of The Southeastern Ohio Song Writers Association.

Michael is survived by his wife of the home; two sons: Justin and Jeremy Cone of McConnelsville; one step-son; Timothy S (Laura) Seitz of Zanesville; his parents; Robert and Dorothy Cone of Amesville; six grandchildren; two great-grandchildren and one brother: Pat Cone of Amesville
