At one time he was owner and operator of the Sinclair Gas Station on Maysville Avenue, retiring from Cooper Industries. He was a member of the SAL, American Legion Post 29, the Zanesville Eagles Aire 302 and the Muskingum County Genealogy Society.

He was instrumental in starting the first men's slow pitch softball league and was a member of the Berger Beer and Lime Material teams. He also won several championships while on a bowling team at Sunrise Bowling Lanes. He also enjoyed playing horseshoes and played on the Sliver Dollar Bar team at one time.

He enjoyed watching the Cleveland Indians, Cleveland Browns, Ohio State Football and Basketball and Loved NASCAR, his favorite being the Ford racing teams. Family members got him in an airplane flying to Las Vegas one time and he traveled several times to Winsor, Canada, and to Hilton Head to play golf,(putt putt) once. He also went many times to spend a week in Columbus, Georgia at Fort Benning visiting Greg while he was in the service. Son of Frederick and Margaret Durant Mehling Joseph, he was born on the family farm on Dietz Lane, December 23, 1938. He started school at St. Nicholas and went to Philo in the 9th grade, being on the football team, and

graduating with the class of 1959.

Preceding him in death are his brothers, Robert Mehling, Raymond Mehling, Donald Mehling, Louis Joseph and Carl Joseph; and infant sister, Celeste Joseph; grandchildren, Joshua and Julie Joseph and Katie Lea Tipton' he was also preceded in death by the mother of Greg and Yvette, Pauline F.
