Reynold "Rennie" Eugene Posey, 88 of Zanesville, Ohio, passed away peacefully, Tuesday January 31, 2017 at Genesis Morrison House Hospice. Reynold married the former Mary Angela Coffman on June 26, 1954, Eaton, OH, and was employed by, Chrysler Airtemp, Dayton, OH, where he retired after 25 years and then worked for Gould Industries, McConnellsville, OH and

McGraw Edison (Cooper Industries) Zanesville, OH where he was the LMO (last man out) after closing the plant. He remained a consultant for Cooper monitoring, wells, buildings and other assets. Rennie enjoyed just about everything (Life in General) from woodworking, gardening, golf, watching his favorite team on TV (Georgia Tech, OSU, Detroit Tigers, Detroit Lion, Reds, Bengals, Purdue football and especially any Georgia Tech boy on the PGA tour). Rennie even found some extra time to relax and read.

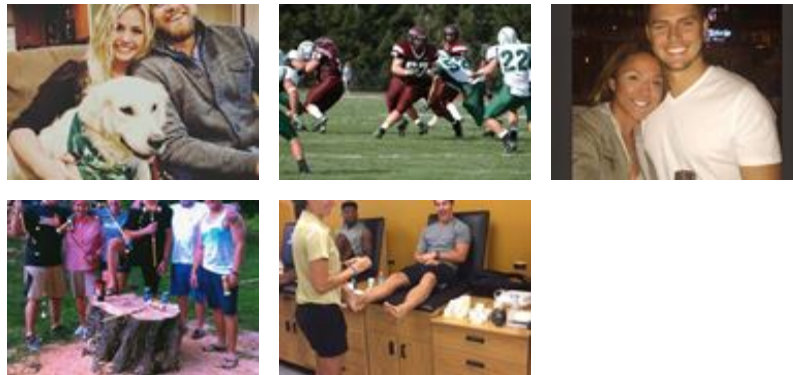
