Richard "Dick" B. Dooley, 72 of Zanesville, died , Monday, September 23, 2019, at Genesis Hospital following a sudden illness. He was born Tuesday, December 17, 1946, in Zanesville, the son of John and Frances (Hooper) Dooley. He married Sue A. (Ball) Dooley on Saturday, September 11, 1971, and was a member of St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church.

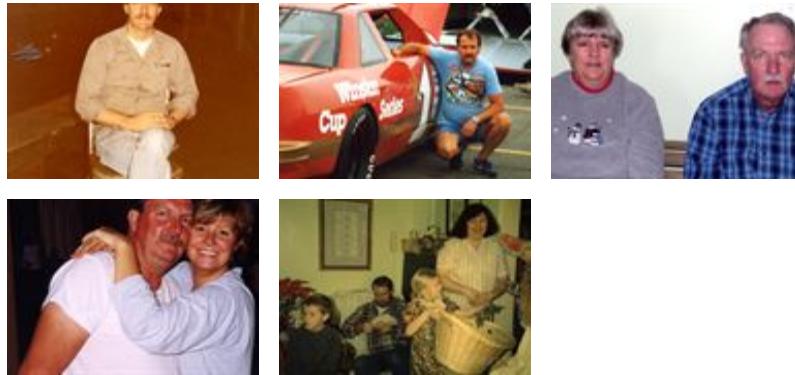
