Ronald J. "Ron" Frame, 72 of Zanesville, died 10:50 AM Monday, September 29, 2014 at Genesis Morrison House Hospice, following a very brief illness. He was born Monday, August 17, 1942 in Zanesville, the son of Joseph Russell Frame and Hazel M. (Watton) Frame.

Ron was owner and operator of Ron Frame State Farm Insurance Agency for over 39 years. He was a former member of St. Nicholas Catholic Church and an active member of Saint Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church. He served on the St. Nicholas School Board for several years and he served on several boards and committees including church council at St. Thomas. Ron was a lifelong avid hunter and fisherman who enjoyed rabbit, deer and squirrel hunting and he delighted in his many fishing trips to Canada. 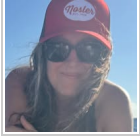
