Susan "Susie" R. Shannon, age 82 of Zanesville, died 6:06 AM, Wednesday, June 26, 2024, at Oaks at Northpointe in Zanesville. She was born Monday, September 22, 1941, in Newark, the daughter of Bela M. Rada and Katherine L.(White) Rada. She was married on Saturday, August 19, 1978, to Paul F. Shannon for 39 years, who preceded her in death on Friday, March 30, 2018. Throughout Susie's career since 1956, she held a variety of employment positions and enjoyed each of them. She worked at Ohio Power, Park National Bank, Orr Chiropractic and McCollister Real Estate.
