Terrence C. "Terry" Zahn, 74 of Zanesville died 6:15 AM Tuesday, March 15, 2011 at Genesis Good Samaritan ER in Zanesville following a long illness. He was born Monday, April 06, 1936 in Lafayette, IN the son of Powers D. Zahn and Helen (Childs) Zahn Shoemaker. He married Delsie K.
