Thomas J. Pastier, age 80 passed away on Wednesday, December 18, 2013 following an extended illness. Tom was born August 6, 1933 in Salem, OH the son of John and Thelma Hester Pastier. He was a graduate of Salem High School where he played varsity football and basketball. His career with Thompson Newspapers spanned 40 years beginning with the Salem News. He retired as publisher of the Zanesville Times Recorder. After retiring from Thompson Newspapers he worked for Sears for several years and volunteered for Good Samaritan Hospital. He was a member of St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church in Zanesville and a past member of Rotary. Tom loved being with his family and friends.
