

Virginia "Ginny" Rose Gutridge

October 16, 1943 - April 9, 2024

Virginia "Ginny" Rose Gutridge, 80, of Nashport, died 12:15 PM, Tuesday, April 9, 2024, surrounded by her family, at Genesis Morrison House Hospice. She was born Saturday, October 16, 1943, in Zanesville, the daughter of Herman T. Grotegeer and Virginia R. (Bollinger) Grotegeer. She married Carl E. Gutridge on Saturday, July 15, 1967, and was a 1961 Graduate of Bishop Rosecrans High School.

Ginny was a lifelong dedicated member of St. Nicholas Catholic Church, where she served as Eucharistic minister, sang in the choir and was a volunteer in the schools. She was a secretary in the X-Ray Department at Genesis Good Samaritan Hospital, retiring following many years of service. She enjoyed ceramics; was a fantastic cook, enjoyed genealogy and loved to watch the birds. Ginny was a loving and caring wife, mother, grandmother and sister who greatly enjoyed the time she spent with her family and friends, especially her grandchildren.

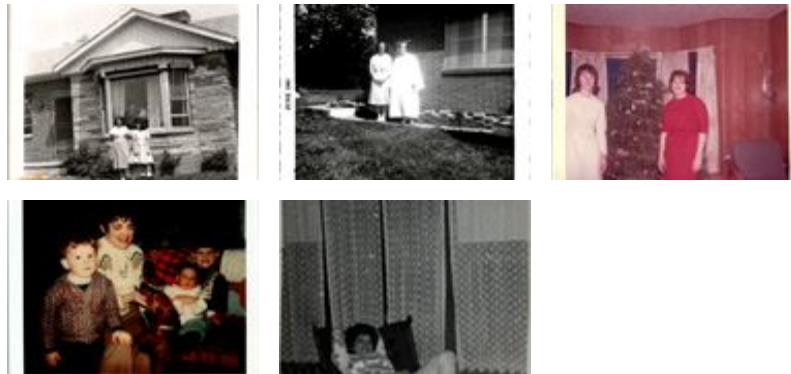
